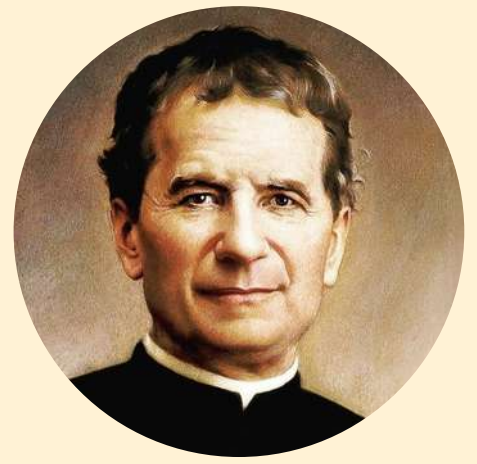

My dear Students,

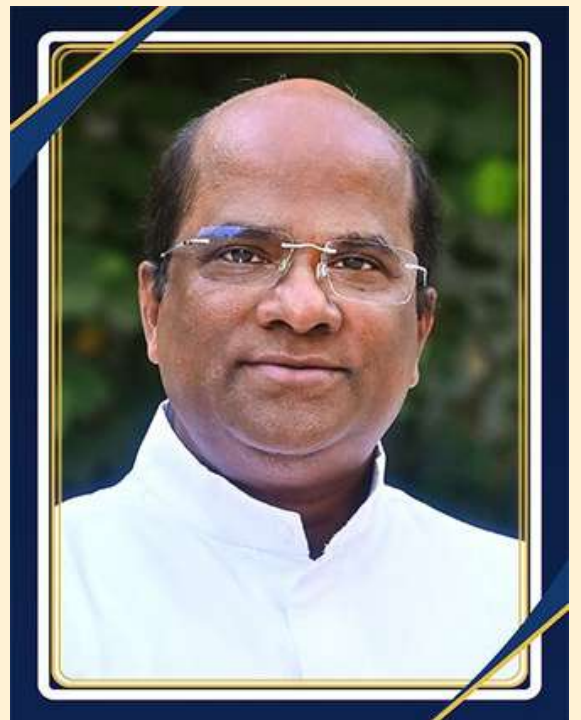
